**Job Description:**

The Academic Fellow is a member of the educational delivery team for a course. The main focus of this role is to complement the professional work of faculty members for courses and/or projects; the Academic Fellow works under the direct guidance of a faculty member. This may involve participation in planning the course handout, preparing and the learning material and course content, conducting tutorials, lab classes and preparing lab manuals, and monitoring and mentoring student projects. BMU's goal is to help develop the Academic Fellow for his/her chosen field of teaching; the training would include conduction of a few classes, for example. He/She will have to meet the needs and expectations of students and course instructors. He/She will also monitor student attendance and record their progress and development.
